Current Parking Regulations For Our Neighborhood

To improve visibility and lower the risk of collisions, particularly at our neighborhood's intersections, **here are the current state and county parking regulations**. These parking regulations are found in RCW 46.04.160, Snohomish County Code 11.04.010 and others.

Enforcing these regulations, either via HOA parking reminder stock cards or by the Snohomish County Sheriff's Dept, will **enhance safety** of both drivers and pedestrians in our neighborhood.

No Parking Within:

- **5 feet of a driveway**
- **15 feet of a fire hydrant**
- **10 feet of a mailbox**
- **20 feet of an intersection crosswalk – marked or unmarked**
- **20 feet of an intersection crosswalk ADA ramp**

Others:

- **Park facing flow of traffic – not opposite**
- **No parking on sidewalks**

First and second options for parking are in the garage and driveway. Street parking is the third option. If street parking is needed, there is room along the lower part of 12th Drive SE, and only limited space elsewhere in the neighborhood due to driveways, mailboxes, fire hydrants and crosswalks/ADA ramps.

Limiting street parking also permits **room for emergency vehicles** such as fire ladder trucks and medical aid units to reach their destination more quickly and safely.

It is **important** for all of us to **inform visitors** of these parking regulations so they avoid any potential infractions.

Enforcement of these parking regulations involves all of us. **Stock card parking notices** under the wipers is one way to inform the motorist of the problem. The other enforcement choice involves the **Snohomish County Sheriff Dept** in Mill Creek. Photos of the offending vehicle helps the arriving deputy.
